ANNUAL VALIDATION REQUIREMENTS

The holder of this license has completed a minimum of 100 controlled freefall parachute jumps to include delayed falls of up to at least 45 seconds. The holder of this license is certified as able to jumpmaster other licensed parachutists and pack his own main parachute; may participate in National and International Record attempts; participate in USPA and FAI sanctioned competitions; make relative-work, night, water and exhibition jumps in accordance with the USPA Basic Safety Regulations; is eligible for USPA Jumpmaster and Instructor Ratings; and is eligible for appointment as a USPA Club Safety Officer or USPA Area Safety Officer.
